Second, through communities of practice, it will offer a space to discuss new and emerging trends, as well as good practices and lessons learned with regards to gender and intersectionalitysin CT/PCVE.

Third, it will offer training opportunities and events on emerging and specialized issues.

The library is accessible to all users regardless of their registration on the Platform. It is searchable by research themes, geographic scope, country, type, and year of publication.

To establish the library, UNOCT consulted willhouther UN entities and civil society. The initial batch of resources was handpicked by two expert consultants after an extensive mapping in 2022.
