Led by the UN Office of Counter-Terrorism, the Programme is implemented in close partnership with the Counter-Terrorism Committee Executive Directorate, the UN Office on Drugs and Crime, the International Civil Aviation Organization, the UN Office of Information and Communication Technology, the International Criminal Police Organization, and the International Organization for Migration.

Today, we will hear presentations by all implementing partners, highlighting the key expertise that each brings to this very successful Programme.

I use the term 'successful' as an independent evaluation of the Programme has recently been completed, which has highlighted its relevance, coherence, efficiency, impact, and valuable contribution in addressing the critical needs of Member States to establish or strengthen their threat detection capabilities.

The report also highlights the 'All-of-UN' approach as a good practice to be replicated.

Since the Programme's launch, 66 countries have joined this partnership.
