MR. CHAIRMAN,

THE PHILIPPINE DELEGATION WOULD LKE TO EXPRESS OUR APPRECIATION FOR THE HEROIC EFFORTS OF YOURUREAU TO RECONCLE THE DIVERGENT INTERESTS AND POSITIONS EXPRESSED IN THE PROCESS OF FORMULATING INPUTS TO THE CHAIR'S DRAFT.

IN VIEW OF THE INCREASING MOBILITY OF OUR MIGRANT POPULATION, IT IS OUR HOPE THAT THE INTERESTS OF SOCCESSOR GENERATIONS OF MIGRANT CHILDREN AND THE CHILDREN OF MIGRANTS, PARTICULARLY THEIR RIGHT TO NATIONALITY, WILL REMAIN AT THE FOREFRONT OF FUTURE DISCUSSIONS. GIVEN THE VULNERABILITIES ATTENDANT TO BEING STATELESS OR UNDOCUMENTED, THIS SITUATION CAN ONLY RESULT TO INCREASING THE NUMBER OF IRREGULAR MIGRANTS, AND IN TURN, WILL FURTHER RAISE ISSUES TO NO END.
