10. Connecting Diasporas for Development (CD4D) (2016-2019)

IOM The Hague, funded by the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs, has commissioned UNU-MERIT/MGSoG to conduct an evaluation of the *Connecting Diaspora for Development Programme*. The programme links diaspora members with Dutch residency to institutions in their countries of origin to participate in short term return assignments aimed at knowledge transfer and capacity building. This is done via physical and online assignments with organisations in Afghanistan, Ethiopia, Ghana, Morocco, Sierra Leone and Somalia.

The desk study provides the basis for decision-making on potential partner countries, sectors and target groups for labour mobility schemes to Germany. These labour mobility schemes focused on employment and/or training of people from different educational levels. They are aimed at maximising the development potential for partner countries by stimulating brain gain and preventing potential braindrain.
