The purpose of the present onvention is to promote! protect and ensure the full and e) ual ento (ment of all human rights and fundamental freedoms b(all persons with disabilities! and to promote respect for their inherent dignit (.

Persons with disabilities include those who have long7term ph(sical! mental! intellectual or sensor(impairments which in interaction with various barriers ma(hinder their sull and essective participation in societ(on an e)ual basis with others.

1 or the purposes of the present onvention:

To this end! States Parties underta.e:

applicable according to international law.

States Parties shall closel (consult with and activel (involve persons with disabilities! including children with disabilities! through their representative organi 'ations.
- ?. &othing in the present onvention shall assect an (provisions which are more conducive to the reali ation of the rights of persons with disabilities and which ma (be contained in the law of a State Part (or international law in force for that State. There shall be no restriction upon or derogation from an (of the human rights and sundamental freedoms recognided or existing in an (State Part (to the present onvention pursuant to law! conventions! regulation or custom on the pretext that the present onvention does not recognide such rights or freedoms or that it recognides them to a lesser extent.
- @. The provisions of the present onvention shall extend to all parts of states without an (limitations or exceptions.

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- 5. States Parties recogni'e that all persons are e)ual before and under the law and are entitled without an (discrimination to the e)ual protection and e)ual benefit of the law.
- 2. States Parties shall prohibit all discrimination on the basis of disabilit (and guarantee to persons with disabilities e) ual and effective legal protection against discrimination on all grounds.
- 9. -n order to promote e) ualit (and eliminate discrimination! States Parties shall ta.e all appropriate steps to ensure that reasonable accommodation is provided.

States Parties shall ta.e all appropriate measures to promote the ph(sical! cognitive and ps(chological recover(! rehabilitation and social reintegration o\$ persons with disabilities who become victims o\$ an(\$orm o\$ exploitation! violence or abuse! including through the provision o\$ protection services. - 9. States Parties shall assume responsibilit (for the dissemination of these statistics and ensure their accessibilit (to persons with disabilities and others.

- 2. -\$ a State Part(is signi\$icantl(overdue in the submission o\$ a report! the ommittee ma(noti\$(the State Part(concerned o\$ the need to examine the implementation o\$ the present onvention in that State Part(! on the basis o\$ reliable in\$ormation available to the ommittee! i\$ the relevant report is not submitted within three months \$ollowing the noti\$ication. The ommittee shall invite the State Part(concerned to participate in such examination. Should the State Part(respond b(submitting the relevant report! the provisions o\$ paragraph 5 o\$ this article will appl(.
- 9. The Secretar(7Ceneral os the %nited &ations shall ma.e available the reports to all States Parties.
- ?. States Parties shall ma.e their reports widel (available to the public in their own countries and \$acilitate access to the suggestions and general recommendations relating to these reports.
- @. The ommittee shall transmit! as it ma(consider appropriate! to the speciali'ed agencies! \$unds and programmes o\$ the %nited &ations! and other competent bodies! reports \$rom States Parties in order to address a re)uest or indication o\$ a need \$or technical advice or assistance contained therein! along with the ommittee>s observations and recommendations! i\$ an(! on these re)uests or indications.

- 2. -n its relationship with States Parties! the ommittee shall give due consideration to wa(s and means o\\$ enhancing national capacities \\$ or the implementation o\\$ the present onvention! including through international cooperation.
