NATIONAL VOLUNTARY PRESENTATIONS (NVP)

What is the mandate of the NVP?

The 2005 World Summit mandated the United Nations Economic and Social Council to undertake an Annual Ministerial Review (AMR) of progress made in the implementation of the internationally agreed development goals (IADGs), including the MDGs. Subsequently, the General Assembly recommended holding National Voluntary Presentations during the AMR. Presentations are based on countries' respective national development strategy (NDS) or policies and their implementation.

What will the NVP do?

Countries will present strategies and policies that have worked and those that haven't and identify practical measures on how to respond. They will also present policies and initiatives which merit scaling up or could be replicated. The policies and experiences critically
