Madam(Mr.) Chair,

Hungary aligns itself with the tatement of the European Union and wishes to make a few observations in its national capacity.

As crimes against humanityose a serious threat to the international community and the rules-based international ordestrong and effective legal measures densired to preventhemand bring perpetrators to justice linke war crimes and genocide crimes against humanity still fall mostly outside the treaty framework. Therefore, it is long overdue to address this legal gap with a convention that solely by its existence, would help to fight impunity and would also reflect the strong determination of the international community in this regard.
