The data gathering activities of UN bodies must not lead to a unilateral formulation of rule of law indicators and ranking of countries in any manner. Those indicators of rule of law which have not been agreed upon by Member States in an open expression is not absolute, its exercise should be carried with responsibilities in accordance with the relevant international human rights law and instruments.

Finally, **Mr. Chairman**, we encourage Member States to continue their efforts to construct an agreeable subtopic for the debate in the next session as well as for the report of the Secretary-General.
