## PROTECTION, SECURITY AND SAFETY OF DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR MISSIONS AND REPRESENTATIVES

1. The Philippine Government provides the following information on incidents affecting the security and safety of diplomatic missions or their personnel that have taken place within its territory during the relevant reporting period: Fire causing property damage; Federation; and
  - e. Apprehension and custody of individuals; guidelines on the mandatory reporting of individuals committing offenses such as assault on a person in authority, resisting a law enforcement officer
2. For a and b above, the Philippine National Police crime and increased security personnel are deployed to diplomatic missions and residences. For c, the Department of Foreign Affairs facilitated discussions with the concerned parties for the resolution and/or reparation of damage.  
  
On d, the employees
