My delegation aligns itself with the statement delivered by the distinguished representative of the Eurepan Union and would like traciteratea fewbrief remarks in a national capacity conceing the provisions under Cluster 5

Italy supports the inclusion of draft Article 5 as drafted by the International Law Commission The principle of non-refoulement with regard to risk of crimes against humanity is reflective of a general principle of ternational human rights law, which is found in the relevant provisions to fe Fourth Geneva Convention f the 1951 Convention relaing to the Status of Refuge of the 1984 UN Convention against Torture and f the 2006 International Convention on Enforced Disappearance.

Italy also finds of great importance draft Article 11, since the provision expressly recognizes the right to a fair treatment and to fair trial of the actions are determined or the constitutional guarantees and ernational human rights standards. Regardless of the gravity of the offence states are under an obligation to fully respect those
