The draft resolution is best on resolution 77/14 adopted last year, ith the necessary technical updates, and incorporatell newlements in the text of Chapter I Tecommendations and Conclusions, as contained in paragraph 16 of the Poort of the Host Country Committee (A/782).

Ill nowddress the followngnaor changs wich we made to the draft resolution.

In perative Paragaph 2 , the newlangage notes the serious concerns raised by a Minber State expressing the inappropriate treatment and screening of certain of its high nking officials by the Host Country and requests the Host Country to carefully investigate these concerns and take the necessary preventive and remedial action, as appropriate.

In perative Paragaph 6, the newtext notes the easing n for travel restrictions on two Massions, while remaining concerned abut the additional restrictions applied to one Mission in late 2022.

In Operative Paragraph 7, the new language notes a relative decrease in the percentage of visas not issued and in Operative Paragraph 8, the General Assembly expresses serious concern regarding multiple cases of denial and non-issuance of entry visas.
