### Introduction

- 1. By application dated on 31 May 2010 and filed with the New York registry of the United Nations Dispute Tribunal (UNDT) on 1 June 2010, the applicant contested the "refusal to accept the contribution by Force Intersyndicale to the upcoming SMCC meeting and to agree to [the applicant's] participation as designated representative of [Force Intersyndicale]". He thereby requested the Tribunal to decide by summary judgment, pursuant to article 9 of the UNDT rules of procedure.
- 2. Simultaneously, the applicant filed a request for suspension of action under article 14 of the Tribunal's rules of procedure.

#### **Facts**

- 3. On 1 June 2010, the New York registry of UNDT forwarded the application to the Geneva registry, which registered the case on 2 June 2010.
- 4. On 3 June 2010, the applicant requested a change of venue from Geneva to New York, under article 6, paragraph 2, of the UNDT rules of procedure. The Tribunal rejected such request by order dated 4 June 2010.
- 5. On the same day, counsel for respondent served her response to the request for suspension of action filed simultaneously by the applicant. She raised, inter alia, a number of issues concerning the receivability of an application against the decision in question, including the lack of request for management evaluation.
- 6. By e-mail of 6 June 2010, the applicant conveyed to the Tribunal his decision "to withdraw his request for summary judgment" and to "submit the contested decision to a formal management evaluation, as requested by the Respondent's Counsel".

### Considerations

7. The Tribunal takes note that the applicant withdraws his application at this stage.

## Conclusion

# 8. In view of the foregoing, the Tribunal DECIDES:

This appeal having been withdrawn, it no longer constitutes a matter for adjudication before the Tribunal. Accordingly, the proceedings are closed.
