Green Climate Fund:

The Green Climate Fund (GCF) is dedicated to supporting developing countries' efforts to reduce their greenhouse gas emissions and enhance their ability to respond to climate change. The Fund pays particular attention to the needs of societies that are highly vulnerable to the effects of climate change, in particular Least Developed Countries (LDCs), Small Island Developing States (SIDS), and African States.

GCF and LLDCs:

While GCF has clear mandates with regards to LDCs, SIDS, and Africa in its Governing Instrument and guidance from the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), it does not have a specific mandate for Land-locked developing countries (LLDCs). Yet, GCF has provided USD 5.9B of total financing.
