We support a global approach to the rapid development and scaled-up manufacture of vaccines that are distributed and accessible to all who need them. We proudly hosted the successful Global Vaccine Summit this year in London.

To effectively meet the needs of vulnerable people and communities, we must address all the forms of exclusion that they face. Our \$23 million Rapid Response Fund is based on inclusion, protection, gender, and safeguarding. We are committed to playing our part.

With an estimated 71 million people predicted to be pushed into extreme poverty as a result of the pandemic, coordinated global action for a sustainable and fair recovery has never been more important.

No one is safe until we are all safe.

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) provide an invaluable framework for collaboration, partnership and building back better. They recognise

Developed Countries, and others whose specific characteristics demand urgent and targeted solutions.

The UK, along with our co-leads, will use the Recovering Better workstream to drive a green and inclusive recovery, stressing support for the most vulnerable, to build fairer societies and ensure no one is left behind.

We will continue to champion these ambitions through our presidencies of COP26 and the G7 in 2021. Accelerating progress towards the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the goals of the Paris
